Beginning in late July, NYC DOT will be making improvements to the Morningside Avenue corridor by:

- Removing a lane in each direction and adding left turn lane as needed
- Constructing pedestrian islands at W. 117th, W. 118th, W. 120th and W. 123rd Streets
- Extending the northwest curb of Morningside and Hancock Place
- Extending with color coating the northeast curb at Hancock Place and the southeast curb at W. 126th Street
- Adding a pedestrian signal and new crosswalk at W. 125th Street and Hancock Place

Implementation Starts late July
