Prior Conditions

Eight malls from West 145th Street to West 153rd Street are being partially reconstructed and beautified so that they will be an attractive asset to the community for years to come.

The malls will be given a lush, green appearance with new trees, woody shrubs and perennial plants, and each mall will have a distinctive look. A variety of plants will be placed on the malls with walk-through promenades and sitting areas to provide a buffer to the vehicular traffic along Broadway.

The work, which will be done in phases to minimize any inconvenience, includes replacement of deteriorated game tables, improved ADA access and reconstruction of decorative pavements, walls and fences. Storm water run-off will be reduced with the enhanced plantings.

This project has been made possible through a capital budget allocation by Borough President Scott Stringer.
