

**MEMORANDUM**


Listed below is the updated procedure on Snow Removal within Community Board No. 9 in the eventuality of heavy storms.

**A] Priority Removal:**

1. Major Streets – include W. 125<sup>th</sup>, W. 135<sup>th</sup>, W. 145<sup>th</sup>, RSD, Amsterdam Avenue, Broadway, Henry Hudson Parkway
2. Special Locations:
  - 1] Blocks of local Precincts
  - 2] Blocks of local Fire Houses
  - 3] Blocks adjacent to St. Luke's/Roosevelt
  - 4] 12<sup>th</sup> Avenue to Henry Hudson Entrance
  - 5] All Bus Stops
  - 6] Parks Entries
  - 7] HPD Property Management W. 132<sup>nd</sup> Street
  - 8] Around Schools

**B] Coordination:**

1. WEP/Special Workers (Sanitation/Parks) should be utilized to clear path at bus stops from sidewalks to avoid riders standing in streets;
2. Should Sanitation be blocked from shoveling a street due to doubled parked vehicles, contacts is to be made with Police to have car towed;
3. Should major plowing occur on streets covering fire hydrants, the Fire Department will mark and assist having them uncovered.



4. MTA will utilize their salt spreaders to do at least one pass around Grant Houses and Manhattanville.
5. Assistant for Parks as notified with available manpower.

**C] Special Concerns:**

1. Ice/Skid problems at intersections at the base of inclines or hills.
2. No snow piles on corner around at schools (visibility hazard for Children and drivers).
3. Ice Buildups at catch basins causing hazardous conditions for turning.



**NYC Bus Rapid Transit Study**

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The next step for the BRT project team is to undertake a series of traffic, parking, and transit studies that will examine how local buses and BRT vehicles will interact, how new bus lanes will affect traffic flow, and a variety of other technical and community issues. We anticipate working closely with elected officials, community boards, and affected constituencies along each of the five corridors as we proceed with the demonstration projects.

We are also pleased to announce that during 2007, several BRT elements will be tested and deployed on several routes throughout the city to determine their applicability and feasibility in the unique New York City environment. These features are expected to include: solid-color bus lanes, transit signal priority, real-time customer information at bus stops and on buses, sidewalk extensions at BRT stations, and enhanced enforcement strategies.
