

***Harlem Piers, Economic Development
& Waterfront Committee Minutes,
December 7, 2004***

Decembe 7., 2004:

Mr. John Carbo, Manager of Citarella informed the committee that they hoped to open the retail store on 125th Street in late January or early February. Again, disappointment was expressed that the retail store was not opened during the busiest retail season of the year, Thanksgiving and Christmas. Further, it does not appear that any work is being done on the property. Mr. Carbo assured the committee that they were working on the store and that it would meet the new target date.

The Chair stated that a representative from the *Henry Hudson Scenic By-Way* would be making a presentation this meeting. Information regarding the Scenic By-Way was distributed to committee members so that they would have some knowledge of the topic when the presentation was made. Copies were also given to people who were present and requested them.

Ms Hilary Kitasei from the Henry Hudson Scenic Byway did a slide presentation and give a brief history of Scenic By-ways. There were many questions and an obvious need for additional information. It was suggested that a joint meeting of Harlem Piers, Waterfront, Economic Development Committee; Transportation, Uniform Services, and Landmark, Parks be scheduled since the presentation touched on areas covered by all of these committees. It was agreed that the January 4th, 2005 would be the date of this meeting and that Ms. Kitasei would bring additional people who could answer our questions and address our concerns.
