

***Harlem Piers, Economic Development
& Waterfront Committee
Minutes, November 9, 2004***

Ms. Alyssa Cobb from EDC Waterfront called to inform us that there had been no new information from the Corp of Engineers regarding their request for mitigation in the Harlem Piers Plan, nor have they commented on the suggestion that 365 pilings be placed in the Hudson River in the area of the Harlem Piers to address this mitigation.

Mr. John Carbo from *Citarella* stated that they had met with EDC Real Estate Division and had planned to present some ideas for the development of the property on 126th Street. EDC has told us that they expected to receive information from Citarella in the coming week and would contact us as soon as it was received. Citarella is still scheduling the opening of its retail store on 125th Street for January/February, 2005.

Ms. Savona Bailey McClain made a presentation on the *Harlem & The Heights Cultural Bus Loop* proposal. Discussion on various aspects of the proposal was had and some members requested additional information. Ms. McClain agreed to email it to them before the Executive Board meeting the next day.

The Chair stated that a representative from the *Henry Hudson Scenic By-Way* would be making a presentation at our December 7th meeting. Information regarding the Scenic By-Way was distributed to committee members requesting that they read it to so that they would have some knowledge of the topic when the presentation was made. Copies were also given to people who were present and requested them.
