26th Precinct – Officer Delva gave his report stating that Felony Assaults are the most serious offenses. Grand Larceny are a big problem. On January 20, 2014 2 young men robbed a person, 2 15 year olds were arrested.

DOT Josh Orzeck – The subject of the Morningside Reso was discussed, it was passed by CB9 General Board in December and there will be no changes made to the reso. Mr/ Orzeck stated that DOT will be going back to CB10 where there has been some issues raised regarding the project. CB9 passed a reso regarding the flow of traffic to 20 miles per hour.

The subject Montefiore Park proposal came up regarding the 40 spaces that will be lost to the community and Ms. Thompson stated that the coalition for Montefiore Park should find the parking. Ms. Tyler stated that DOT has the resources and that they should help with finding the parking. Mr. Orzeck stated that usually the Community Boards make that decision, however, DOT will help to find parking.

On the subject of the Signs at 125th Broadway, Key Food did not come before the board regarding the posting of NO PARKING SIGNS, the board is requesting that the signs be removed.

Mr. Kovaleff stated that a letter should go to Key Foods requesting that they come to the next Uniform Service/Transportation Meeting in March.

Mr. Orzeck stated that changes will be made on the #60 Select Bus.

Muni Meters will be placed on 12th Avenue for 1 hour between 8am & 11am.
