The meeting was called to order by Co- Chair Carolyn Thompson at 6:30 p.m.

Chair Carolyn Thompson welcome everyone and introduced the Chair of the Board, Rev. Georgiette Morgan-Thomas and acknowledge DOT presenters, Assembly Member Danny Farrell, Jr. and other city agency representatives.

**Reports:**

**Officer Jason Harper of the 26<sup>th</sup> Precinct** reported that crime is down. The weekly stats for the period of September 22, 2014 through September 28, 2014 are as follows:

**Joselinne Minaya from the District Attorney's Office** reported that "**October is Domestic Violence Awareness Month**" and stated that the Mayor's Office, DA's Office and the Manhattan Family Justice Center created a drive to collecting non-perishable foods, new and used clothing, strollers, car seats baby formula diapers new and used multilingual books in recognition of the Domestic Violence Awareness Month. The NYC Department of Transportation gave a presentation given by Nina Haiman and re:

**Proposed changes to the Intersection of St. Nicholas Place and West 155<sup>th</sup> Street are as follows:**

- Add new pedestrian safety island on St. Nicholas Place at West 155<sup>th</sup> Street
- Install five neckdowns at West 155<sup>th</sup> Street and St. Nicholas
- Install two neckdowns at West 155<sup>th</sup> Street and St. Nicholas Avenue
- Add left turn lane on West 155<sup>th</sup> Street (E/B)
- Modify signal timing to process West 155<sup>th</sup> vehicles through St. Nicholas Place and St. Nicholas Avenue.
- Ban southbound left turns off of West 155<sup>th</sup> Street
- Ban southbound right turns from Edgecombe Avenue
- Ban westbound left turns off of West 155<sup>th</sup> Street

**Proposed changes to St. Nicholas Place:**

- Add pedestrian island at 151<sup>st</sup>, 152<sup>nd</sup>, and 153<sup>rd</sup> Streets
- Add yield crosswalks on St. Nicholas Place at West 152<sup>nd</sup> Street.

After the presentation two committee members had a motion to support the plan, and a vote to table the motion to further discuss the plan to the next Uniform Services and Transportation Committee meeting in November was: 3 approved and 2 opposed and 0 abstentions.

**Public Comments:**

The community residents supported the plan with a vote of 13 approved 0 opposed and 0 abstentions.

**Tompkins Hall Nursery School and Childcare Center**

The Nursery School is requesting speed bumps at Claremont Avenue between 116<sup>th</sup> and 120<sup>th</sup> Avenue. A letter of request and signed petition was submitted.

**NYPD 26<sup>th</sup> Precinct**

Requested parking space at 129<sup>th</sup> Street on the Southside of the street and remove signs that reads "No Parking between 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m." to alternative parking signs


