2014 New York City Coalition Against Hunger 2014 Survey showed:

- One in six New York City residents – Over 1.4 million – are food insecure.
- Nearly one in four children in New York City are food insecure.
- One in 10 NYC seniors are food insecure.

To stamp out hunger, the Manhattan Borough President's Office in collaboration with West Side Campaign Against Hunger are initiating a demonstration project that will allow us to screen, apply and recertify individuals and families who qualify for SNAP (food stamps) benefits at the following site:
