**Café Swish Reso**

Whereas: the pedestrian traffic is very heavy in the area in front of Café Swish located at XXX Broadway [Between 115 and 116 street on the west side of the street];

Whereas: CB9M has had a policy which limits sidewalk cafes to extending no more than eight feet from the building line for XXX years;

Whereas: the funneling of heavy pedestrian traffic can produce dangerous conditions especially when there is a nearby bus stop and a high concentration of senior citizens;

Whereas; Department of Consumer Affairs allowed Café Deluxe eight feet six inches from the building line;

Whereas: the manager of Café Swish met with members of the Transportation/Uniformed Services Committee agreed to the eight foot six inch parameters and marked them on the sidewalk;

Therefore be it resolved that CB9M goes on record as supporting Café Swish's application for a renewal of its sidewalk café permit *provided it extend no further than eight feet six inches from the building line.*
