## **Patrol Borough Manhattan North's 5 Steps to Identify Gang Involvement**

Today's teenagers are all trying to be part of something. Unfortunately, this includes joining or participating in groups involved in criminal activity. These groups may be placed in 2 categories:

- Gangs(traditional)
  - Bloods, Crips, Latin Kings, Trinitaros, DDPs
- Crews
  - usually use 3 letters such as OYG, FDZ, 2MF, etc
  - usually locally based (single block, development)

To determine if your child is in a gang or crew, parents should:

### **Identify the Problem**

- Look for graffiti on
  - Notebooks & schoolbags
  - Walls in bedrooms, hallways, and stairways
- Internet
  - Check Facebook, Myspace pages, You Tube, computer history
- Cell phones
  - Pictures, videos, screen savers
  - Do they have internet access on their phones? Why?

### **Educate Yourself**

- Contact Precinct Youth Officer
  - Ask for updated neighborhood groups
- Contact local youth organizations
- Internet
  - Do you know their friends, friends' parents, etc

### **Formulate a Plan**

- What are my options?
  - Move computer to common area
  - Eliminate media package from cell phone
- Alternatives to gang activity
  - Programs available in the neighborhood

### **Discuss the issue**

- Are they receptive or in denial?
- Explain the dangers
- Understand/acknowledge their opinion

### **Take Action**

- Set parameters for their activity
  - Including internet pages and cell phones
