New York City Transit and DOT was present and presented the M-60 Bus Project.

The proposal is to make the M-60 Bus a Select Bus which would make the traffic along 125<sup>th</sup> Street move a little faster. Mr. Aaron Sugiura of NYCDOT stated that they have reached out to the vendors regarding curb side pickups for delivery. Mr. Sugiura further stated that parking on 125<sup>th</sup> Street will remain the same.

Mr. Kovaleff, had many suggestions but states that he supports the project, but if the that M-60 bus does not stops across from the State building he would not support it. Mr. Evan Bialostozky of New York City Transit stated that they had heard many people state the same thing at the Community Advisory Meeting that NYC Transit and DOT have been having.

The subject of the angle parking located at 125<sup>th</sup> Street Amsterdam Avenue for the Fire Department vehicles was brought up, Ms. Thompson recommended that NYC Transit/DOT should remove triangle and make it for Fire Department vehicle only. NYC Transit/DOT stated that they would take that into consideration. The NYC/Transit/DOT further stated that they will be removing some of the stops in queens.

Josh Orzeck – DOT was in attendance along with NYC Transit, Mr. Orzeck stated that the next round of discussion regarding the M-60 with be held on March 18, 2013 in the Crystal Ballroom of the Alhambra Ballroom at 2116 Adam Clayton Powell Boulevard.


