Dear Ms. Morales:

This letter is written to advise that the New York City Housing Authority (“NYCHA” or “Authority”) is amending its FY 2009 Annual Plan to incorporate Section 18 Demolition/Disposition activity at Justice Thurgood Marshall Plaza (AMP # NY005011250) located in New York County.

NYCHA will submit an application on-line for the disposition under Section 18 of the Housing Act of 1937, as amended, to dispose of the unused playground, six-space parking lot and a portion of the rear building courtyard comprising approximately 16,653 square feet of land at Marshall Plaza. The parcel would accommodate the construction of a multi-use facility including a 572-seat public partnership school and a relocated community health clinic. The proposed disposition does not affect any public housing units.


Residents of Marshall Plaza and the Manhattan North Citywide Council of Presidents (CCOP) have been consulted on the proposed disposition. NYCHA intends to submit the disposition application in spring 2009 and the projected end date of the activity is 2012.

The Authority has determined that this action constitutes a minor change under the provisions of Section 8 of the approved plan. The proposed amendment is not the result of federal statutory change or regulatory change, nor does it have substantial programmatic or financial effect on NYCHA programs or result in substantial obligation or administrative burden on the Authority.

A copy of this amendment will be available to members of the public seeking to examine the FY 2009 Annual Plan. It will be posted on the Authority's website where a copy of the approved FY 2009 Plan is available for public review.
