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NYC-TV grabs eight Emmys

NYC-TV, the city's suddenly hip cable network, reeled in eight New York Emmy Awards at ceremonies over the weekend.

Channel 25's "Blueprint" - an insider's guide to some of the city's more famous landmarks - grabbed four trophies, including for best camera and editing work for a documentary.

The network's graphics, art direction, public service announcements and promotional spots also took top honors.

The station's eight Emmys were second only to WNBC-TV's nine statues this year, with WCBS-TV and WPIX-TV also garnering eight apiece.

"Everyone at NYC-TV is smiling today," said Arick Wierson, general manager for NYC-TV - the former Crosswalks Television.
