



FINALIZATION STATUS UPDATE

The finalization process, or the process of certifying member's pension benefits, occurs through collaboration between the New York City Police Pension Fund, the Office of the Actuary for the City of New York, and the New York City Comptroller's Office. This process may take six to twelve months from the member's effective date of retirement. Some variables that impact the finalization process can include pending contract settlements, volume, and the time it takes for NYPD Central Payroll to calculate and disburse any retroactive money. Provided below is a summarization of the status of current finalization processes by rank. This will be updated as information becomes available. The following ranks have been finalized by the Police Pension Fund and sent to the NYC Actuary's Office for processing.

Rank	Retirement Date
Police Officer	Up to July 2012
Detective	Up to December 2013
Sergeant	Up to July 2013
Lieutenant	Up to December 2013
Captain & above	Up to December 2013
