Recycle in **GREEN**-labeled recycling containers:

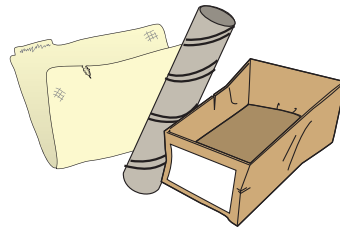
- **white and colored paper** (lined, copier, computer)



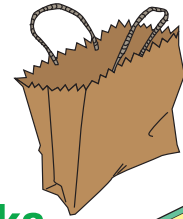
- **mail and envelopes** (any color)



- **smooth cardboard** (boxes, tubes, file folders)



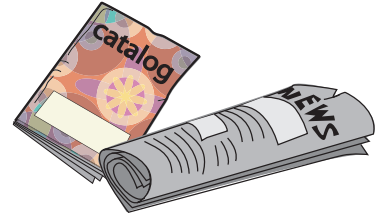
- **paper bags**



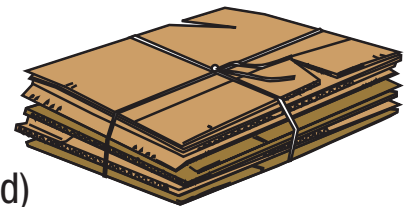
- **soft-cover books, telephone books**



- **newspapers, magazines, catalogs**



- **corrugated cardboard boxes** (flattened and tied)



OK: staples, tape & glue

NO: spiral bindings



What **NOT** To Recycle (place these in the regular trash):

- **soft paper** (napkins, paper towels, tissues)
- **waxed or plastic-coated paper** (candy wrappers, oatmeal & hot chocolate packets, take-out containers)
- **soiled paper**
- **hardcover books**

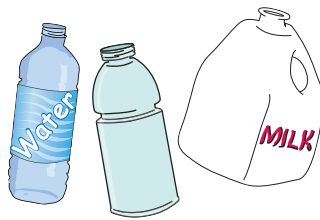

bottles, cans & foil!

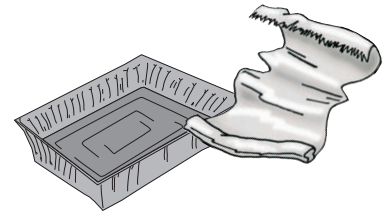


Recycle in **BLUE**-labeled recycling containers:

- plastic bottles & jugs



- aluminum foil wrap & trays



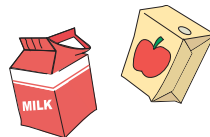
- glass bottles & jars



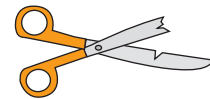
- metal cans



- milk & juice cartons, drink boxes



- other metal items



(scissors, staplers)

Empty food or beverages from all containers.

Redeem 5¢ deposit bottles and cans for refund.



What NOT To Recycle (place these in the regular trash):

- other kinds of plastic
(deli & yogurt containers, plastic cups & straws, plastic utensils, styrofoam)
- other types of glass
(mirrors, light bulbs, ceramics, glassware)
