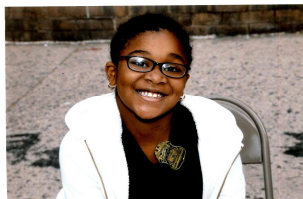

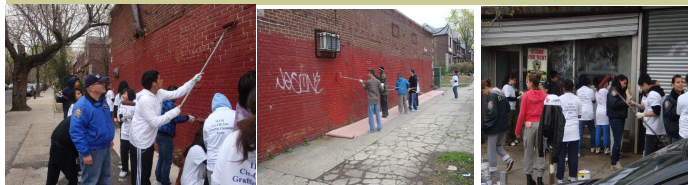
COMMUNITY AFFAIRS BUREAU'S OUTREACH INITIATIVES
