



CENSUS 2010



The current phase of the 2010 U.S. Census is under way as workers have begun visiting households across the country. Your cooperation is important for yourself and everyone else, participation is mandated by law.

To avoid being victimized by person(s) impersonating a census bureau employee, the NYPD is offering the following safety tips:

A legitimate Census Bureau employee should be carrying the following items:

1. An Identification card (can be a photo or non-photo ID)



2. A Census Bureau canvas bag



The NYPD's Crime Prevention Section suggests that you do the following:

- Verify his/her identification
- There is no need to invite anyone into your home, (Census Bureau employees are not permitted to enter anyone's home)
- Census Bureau employees are verifying address information & number of occupants, DOB, therefore...

DON'T GIVE OUT:

- Social Security Number
- Credit card information
- Bank account information
- Account Passwords or PIN#'s

REMEMBER
Census Bureau employees will NEVER solicit donations

If you suspect criminal activity:

- Stay inside your home
- Don't open the door
