2008 MANHATTAN GUN BUY BACK PROGRAM

Frequently Asked Questions:

HOW DO I BRING A GUN TO THE DROP OFF SITE?

- Gun must be put in a plastic or paper bag or in a shoe box.

CAN I TRANSPORT THE GUN IN A CAR?

- If transporting the gun by car, gun must be transported in the trunk of the car.

WHEN DO I GET THE CASH CARD?

- After the gun is screened by officers, and determined to be a working firearm, a cash card will be given. This card is valid for 30 days from date of issuance.

CAN I SURRENDER A RIFLE OR SHOTGUN?

- In addition to hand guns, rifles and shotguns will be accepted.

CAN I SURRENDER BB GUNS OR AIR PISTOLS?

- BB guns and Air pistols will be accepted and a \$20.00 cash card will be given.

HOW MANY GUNS CAN I SURRENDER?

- You can surrender as many guns as you wish but you will only be paid for three guns.

IS THERE A PHONE NUMBER I CAN CALL FOR MORE INFORMATION?

- Yes, you can call 311 for information regarding the “Manhattan Gun Buy Back Program.”

CAN ANY MEMBER OF THE PUBLIC SURRENDER A GUN?

- Yes, except guns owned by active or retired law enforcement officers or licensed gun dealers will not be accepted.
