- Conceal expensive electronic equipment and jewelry
- Refrain from listening to music or wearing headphones while riding the transit system
- Be aware of your surroundings if you are using your device
- Be aware that most robberies occur near the train doors
- Be alert for staged distractions
- Carry your wallet in a front pants pocket
- When possible install GPS tracking software on devices to assist in locating, if stolen
