

CERTIFIED IT ADMINISTRATOR (WAN)

The New York City Police Department is seeking qualified candidates to fill Certified IT Administrator (WAN) positions in the Management Information Systems Division. The Certified IT Administrator (WAN) positions serve as a project leader and network technical advisor, responsible for network security and application back-up. This entails performing regular independent validation and verification of network system functionality; conducting vulnerability assessments which include testing firewalls, anti-virus programs, and security protocols; and designing disaster recovery plans.

In addition to meeting the Qualification Requirements, all candidates must possess one of the following Professional Vendor certifications:

Cisco Certified Internetwork Professional (CCIE) Security, CCIE Routing and Switching, or CCIE Service Provider

Cisco Certified Internetwork Professional (CCIP)

Cisco Certified Network Professional (CCNP)

QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

1. A baccalaureate degree from an accredited college, and two (2) years of satisfactory full-time (not classroom based) experience in wide area network planning, design, configuration, installation, troubleshooting, integration, performance monitoring, maintenance, enhancement, and security management; or
2. A four-year high school diploma or its educational equivalent and six (6) years of satisfactory full time (not classroom based) information technology experience of which at least two (2) years must have been as described in "1" above; or
3. A masters degree in computer science or a related field from an accredited college may substitute for one (1) year of experience. However, all candidates must have at least one (1) year of satisfactory (not classroom based) full-time information technology experience as described in "1" above.
