- O Upon completing the sale of the firearm(s), you must come to the License Division to have the firearm(s) removed from your license. A new license will be printed while you wait in Room 152B. Please write your log number on the Bill of Sale and bring a copy to the Incident Section in Room 110A. If no one is present in the Incident Section you may leave the Bill of Sale at the front desk.
- o If you are selling all of the firearms listed on your handgun license, then upon completion of the sale you must send your original handgun license, along with a copy of the Bill of Sale (with log number issued by the License Division), to the Incident Section. The License Division will cancel your license and process the sale request. Mail or fax these documents marked "Attention: License Division Incident Section Supervisor."
- The License Division's hours of operation are from 8:30 AM to 4:00 PM, Monday to Friday. The License Division is closed on all legal holidays.
