

## QUALIFICATIONS

To Qualify for the NYPD Cadet Corps You Must Be:

- A resident of NYC.
- A U.S. Citizen or permanent resident; must have US Citizenship within two (2) years of hire and/or graduation of college – whichever comes first.
- Enrolled at a four (4) year accredited college
- A full-time, matriculated student with a minimum of 45 credits.
- Registered for at least 12 credits per semester.
- Maintain a minimum of 2.0 GPA per semester.
