OER's SPEED Application Wins ACEC New York Diamond Award

On 24 March, the Mayor's Office of Environmental Remediation, Gannett Fleming Engineers and Architects, P.C., and GeoDecisions accepted a Diamond Award in the American Council of Engineering Companies of New York's (ACEC New York) 45th annual Engineering Excellence Awards.

The team was recognized for the development of the Searchable Property Environmental E-Database (SPEED) portal in the Surveying and Mapping Technology category. The Diamond Award is the highest honor bestowed in each category.

SPEED [<http://nyc.gov/speed>] provides environmental information on thousands of NYC properties in an intuitive, map-based interface. It enables its users to view, query, and generate reports on historic land use and environmental conditions and helps them identify and potential environmental cleanup and brownfield redevelopment opportunities.
