

NYC Mayor's Office of Environmental Remediation (OER) – Internships

Fellowship/Internship in Environmental Law

The city Office of Environmental Remediation (OER) seeks a recent law school graduate or third year law student for an unpaid fellowship or internship in environmental law. The Office of Environmental Remediation, an outgrowth of PlaNYC 2030, Mayor Bloomberg's sustainability plan, operates the nation's only voluntary brownfield cleanup program run by a municipality.

The fellow/intern will assist OER's General Counsel in conducting a broad range of research into federal and state environmental law. Specific matters likely to be addressed in 2012 include drafting a city rule on the city's E-designation program, revising the city's brownfield grant rules, and developing strategies to assist small businesses obtain liability protection in connection with recent federal decisions to place NYC water bodies on the National Priority List.
