One of the 127 PlaNYC initiatives, MillionTreesNYC is a citywide, public-private program with an ambitious goal: to plant and care for one million new trees across the city's five boroughs by 2017. It is a partnership between NYC Parks and the New York Restoration project to increase our city's urban forest by planting trees in streets, parks, and public, private and commercial land. We've hit our halfway mark of 500,000 new trees in New York City.
