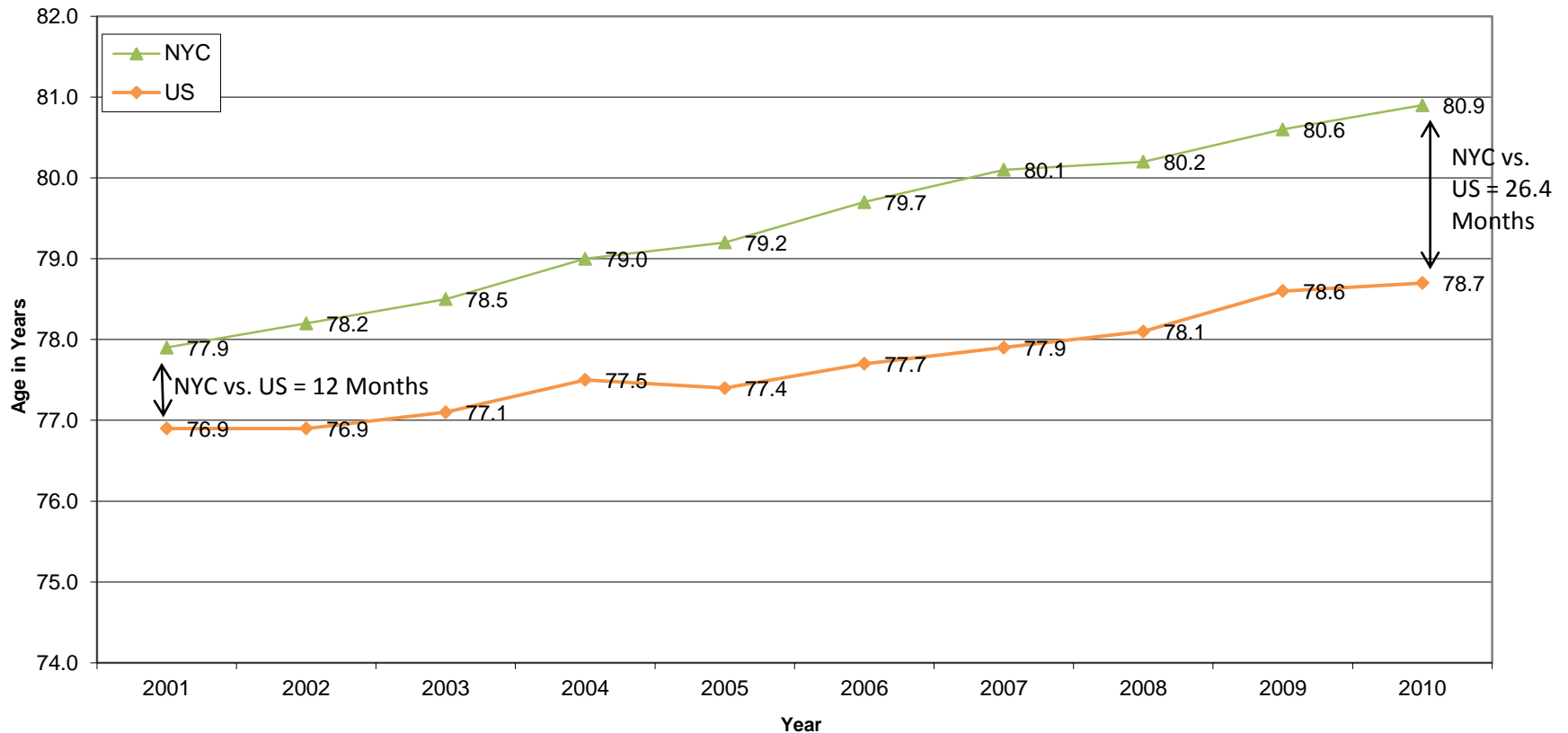


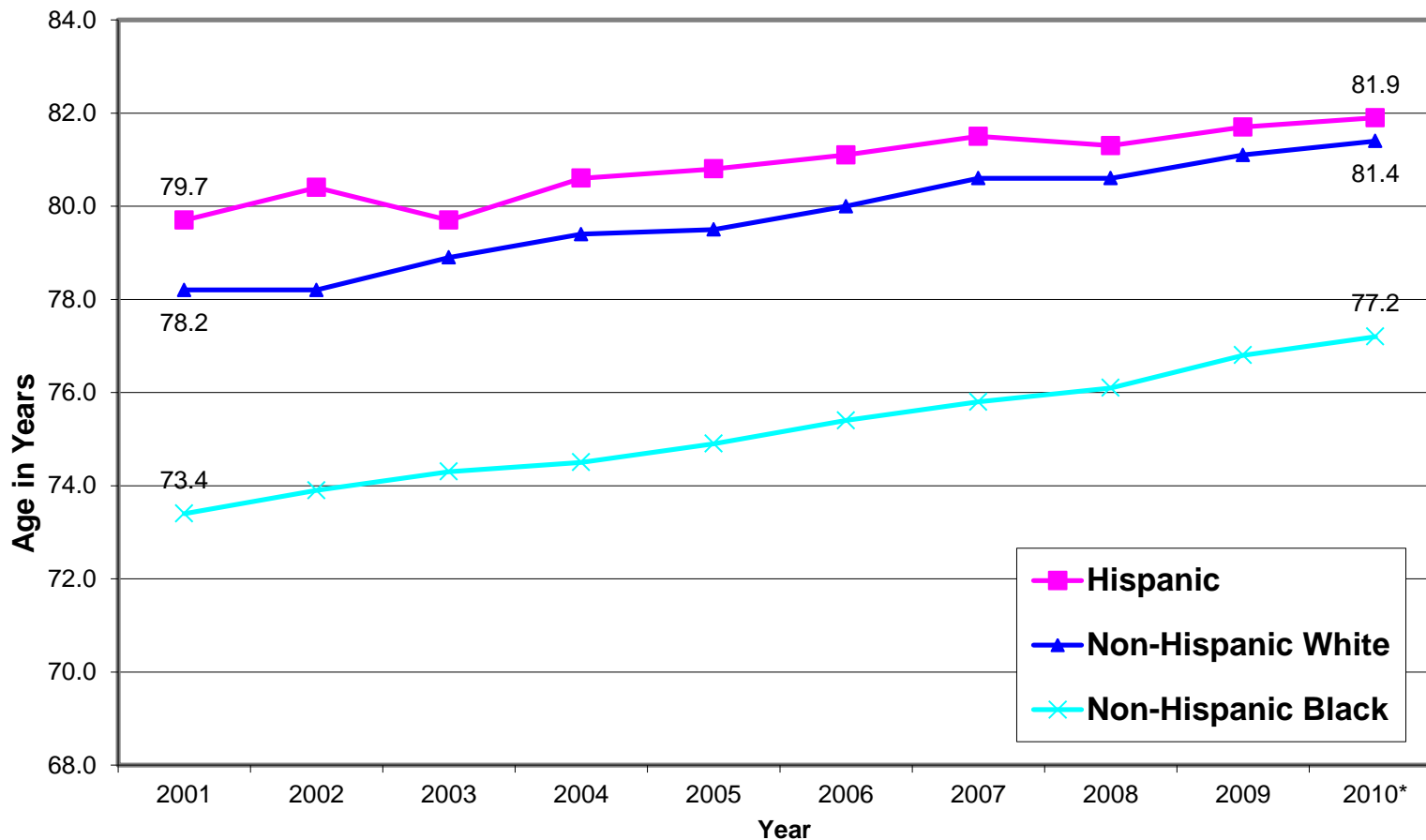
Life Expectancy at Birth, New York City and US, 2001-2010

Life Expectancy at Birth by Race/Ethnicity New York City, 2001-2010



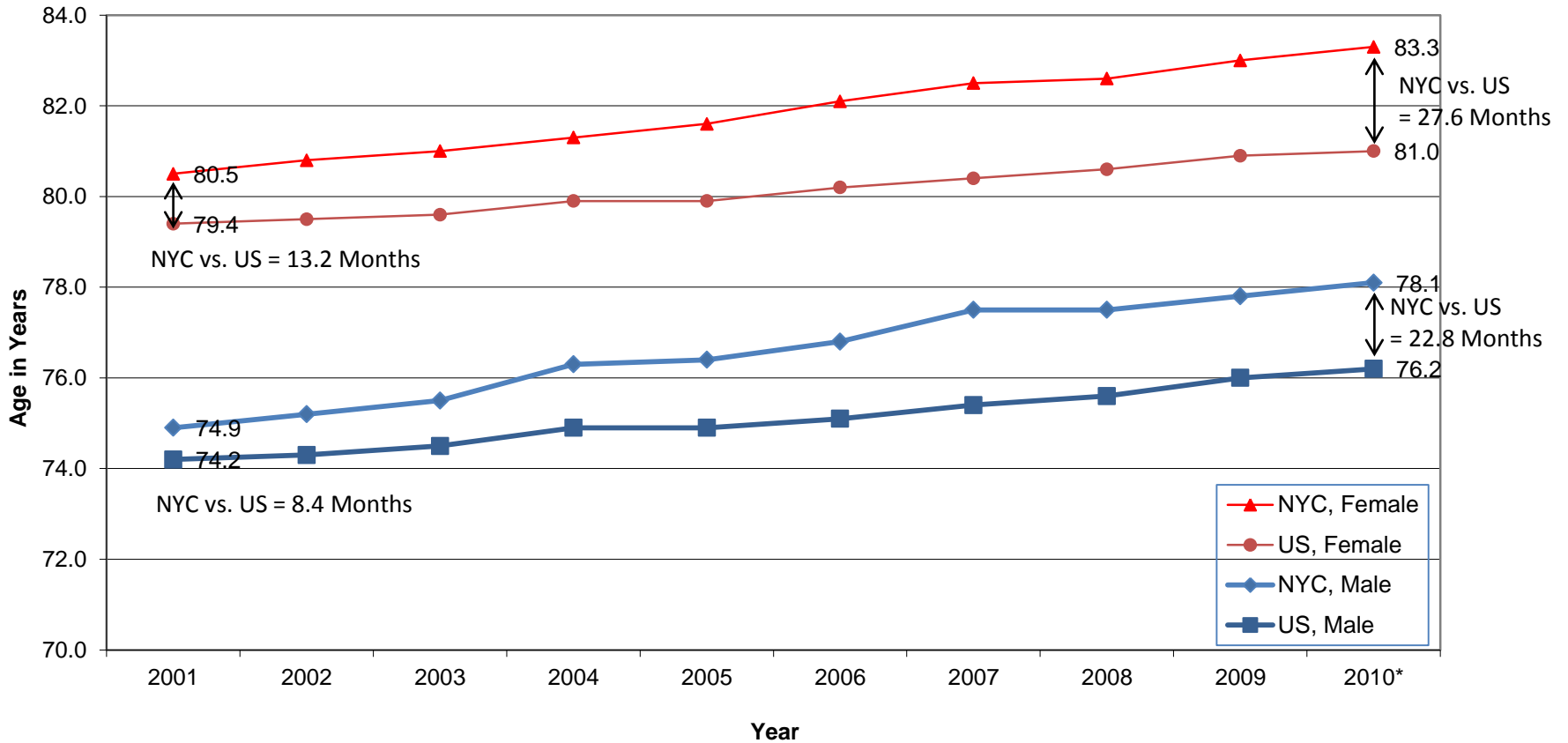

Life Expectancy at Birth by Sex, New York City and U.S., 2001-2010



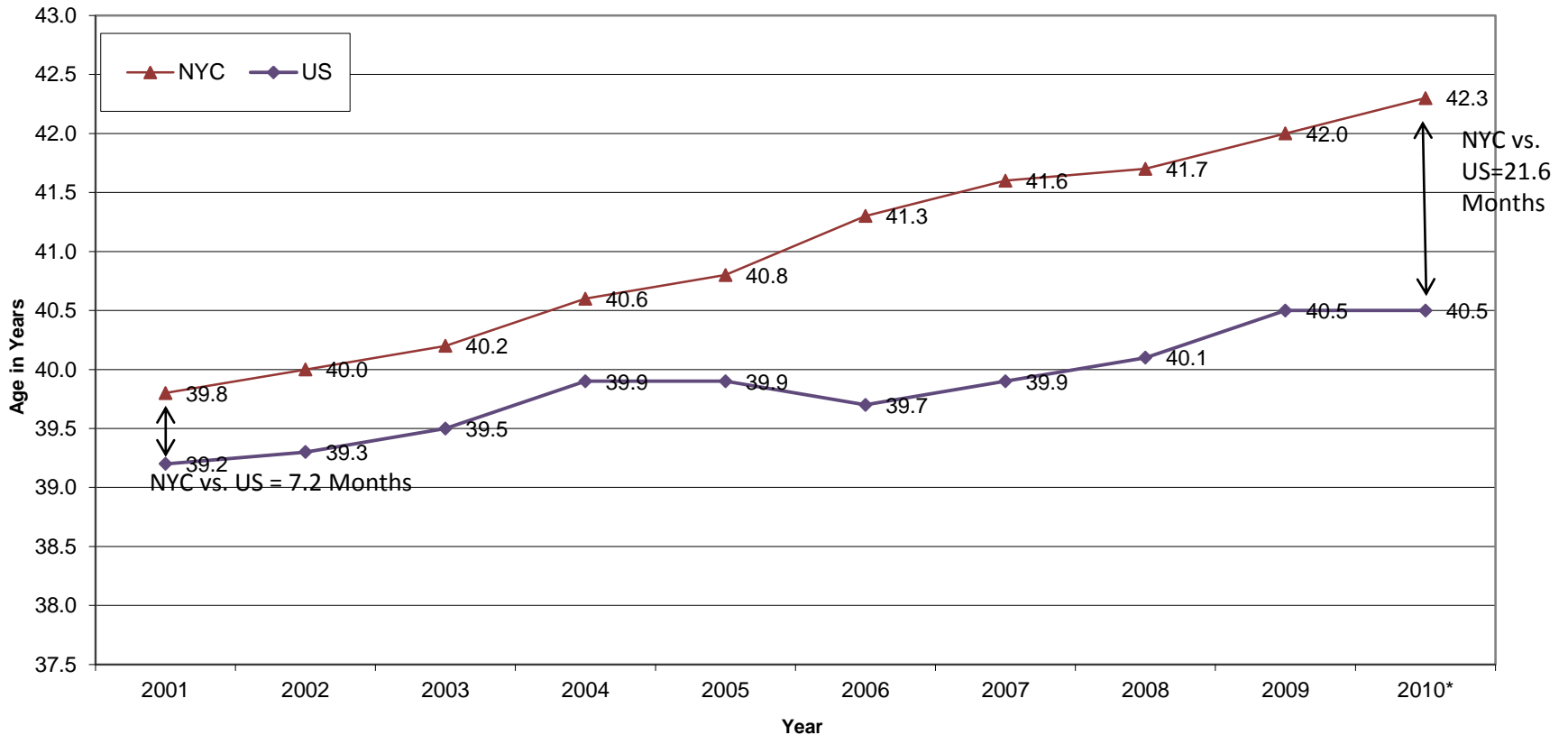

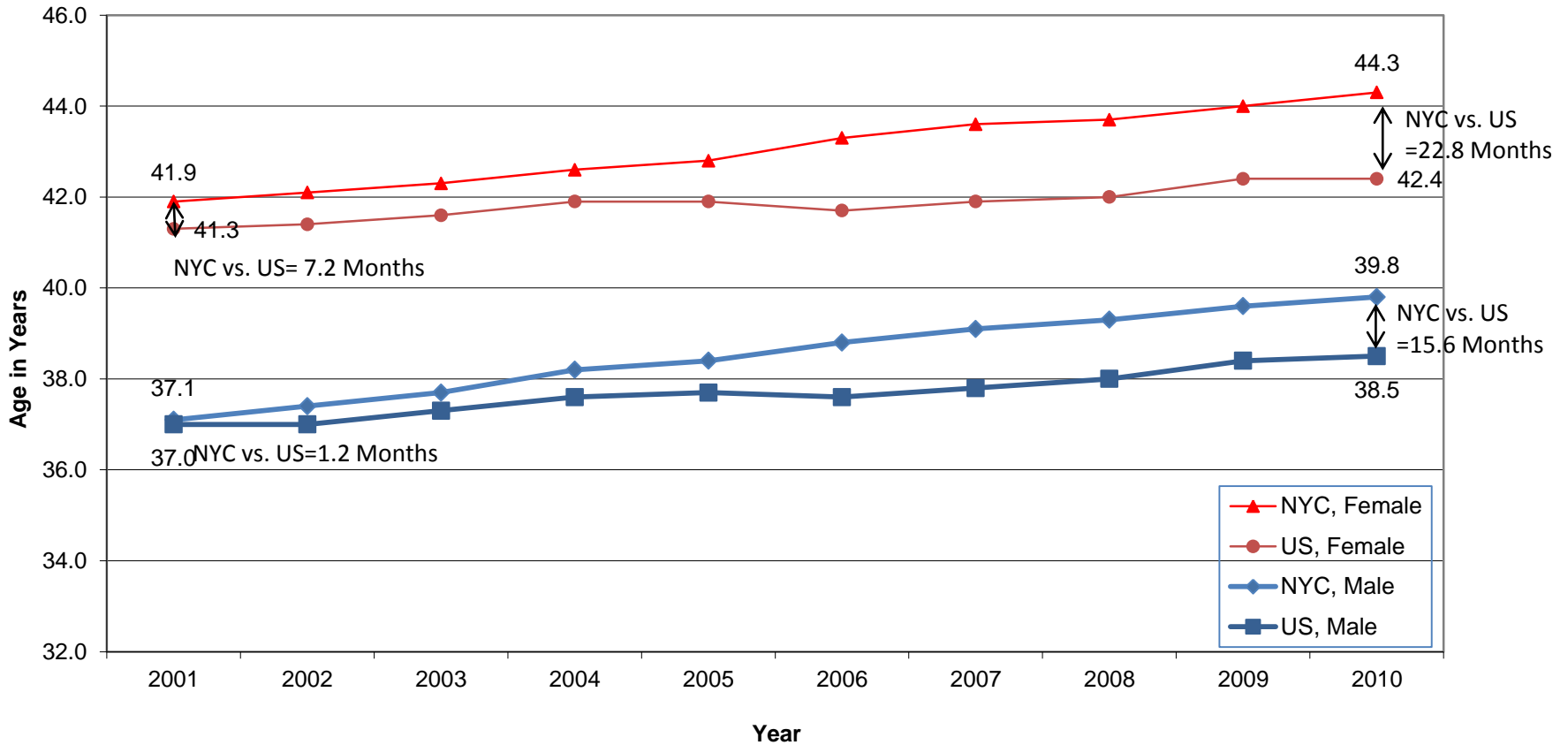
Additional Years of Expected Life (Life Expectancy) at Age 40 New York City and US, 2001-2010

Additional Years of Expected Life (Life Expectancy) at Age 40 by Sex New York City and U.S., 2001-2010



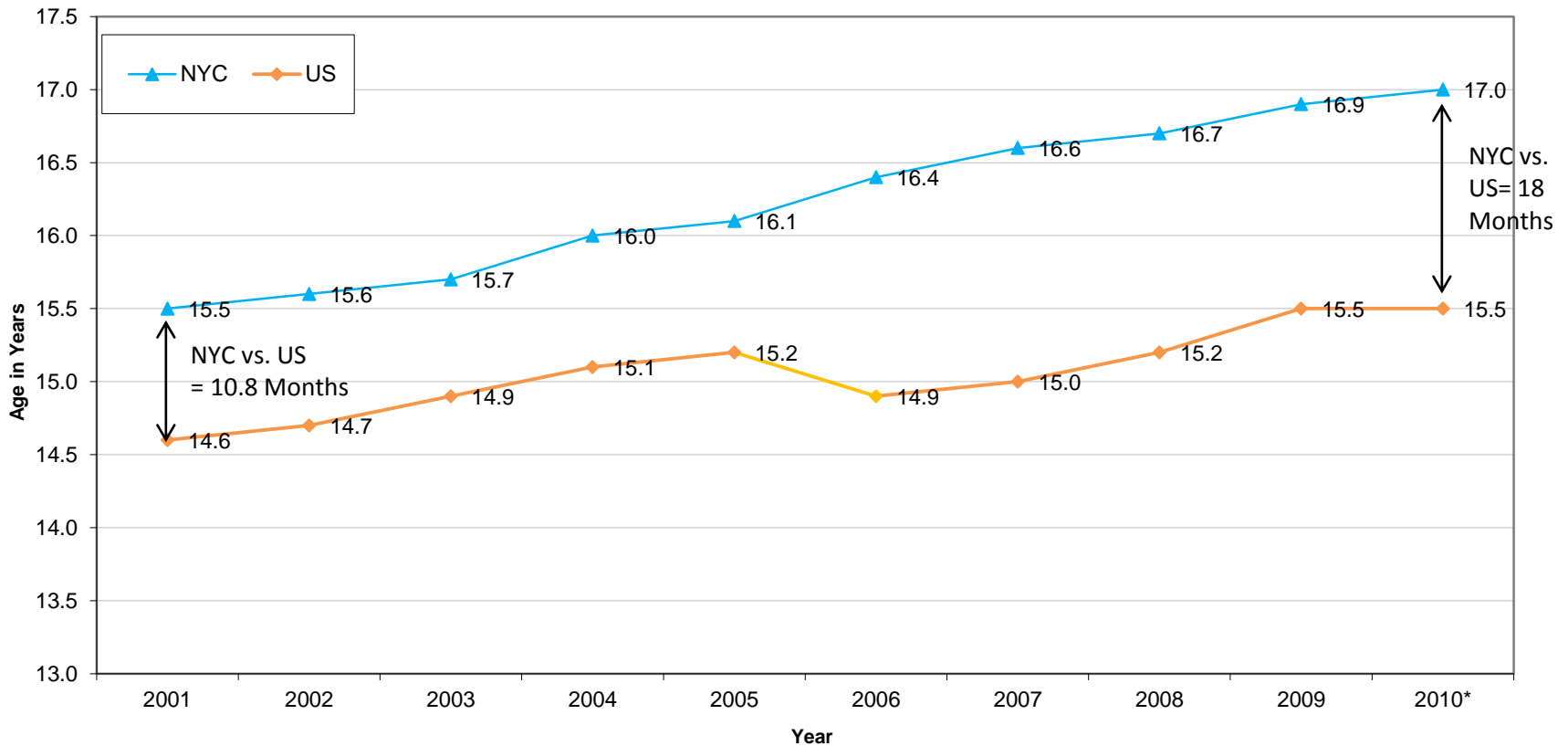

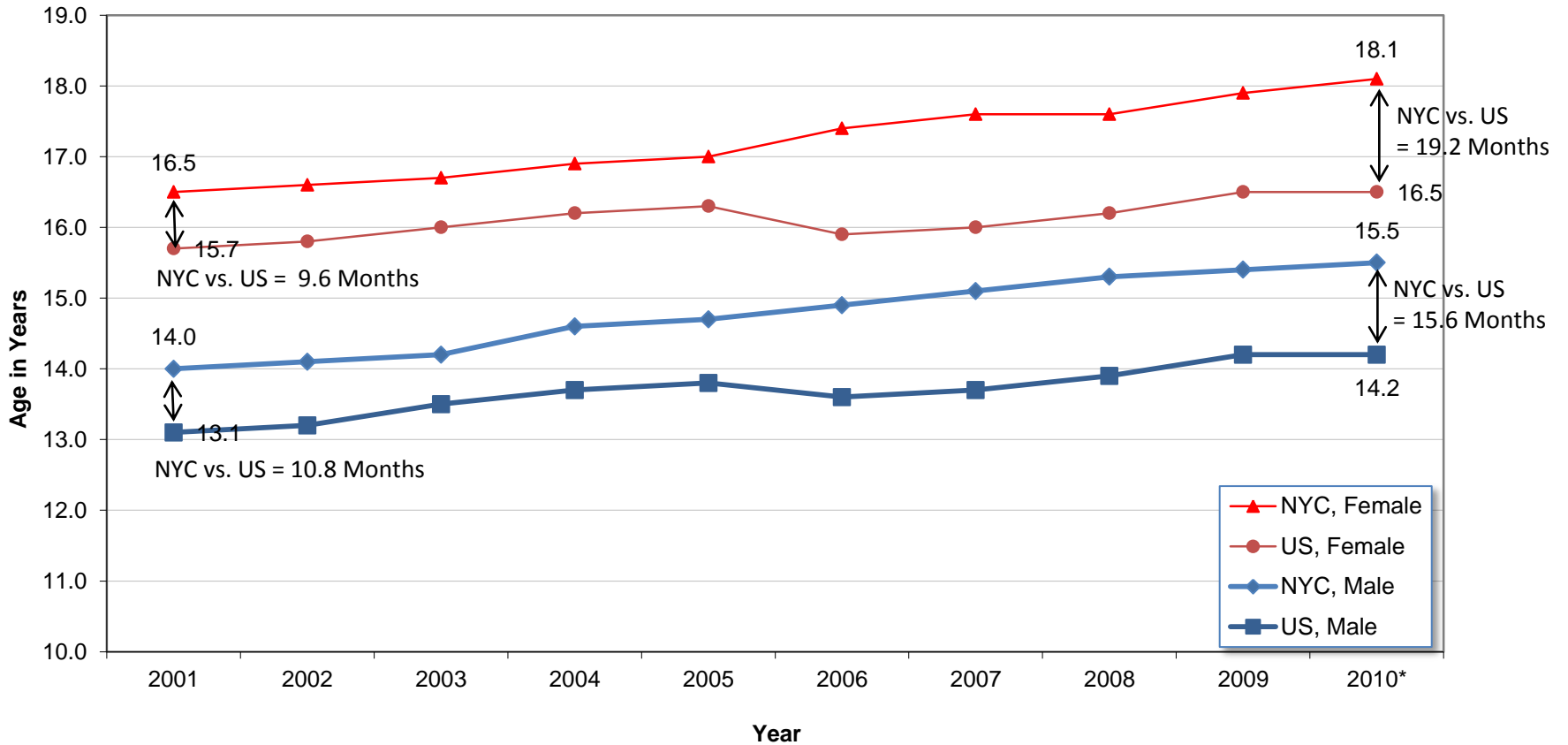
Additional Years of Expected Life (Life Expectancy) at Age 70 New York City and US, 2001-2010
