EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 290

EXTENSION OF EMERGENCY ORDER REGARDING WAIVER OF FEES RELATED TO  
THE OPERATION OF STORM DAMAGED BUSINESSES

April 1, 2013

WHEREAS, Executive Order 282, issued March 27, 2013, contains a proclamation extending a state of emergency in the City of New York, and such proclamation remains in effect for a period not to exceed thirty days or until rescinded, whichever occurs first; and

WHEREAS, on October 26, 2012, the Governor issued a declaration of emergency for all counties in the State of New York, including the City of New York, and such declaration remains in effect for a period not to exceed six months or until rescinded, whichever occurs first;

WHEREAS, Executive Order 246, issued February 20, 2013, contains an emergency order regarding waiver of fees related to the operation of storm damaged businesses;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ordered:

§ 1. The emergency order regarding waiver of certain fees related to the operation of storm damaged businesses forth in Executive Order 246 is hereby extended for five days.

§ 2. This Order shall take effect immediately. It shall remain in effect for five (5) days unless it is terminated or modified at an earlier date.
