Mayor’s Management Report

STATUS OF PROPOSALS FOR FY 2014-2015 CITYWIDE STATEMENT OF NEEDS

Section 204 of the City Charter requires the Mayor to submit an annual Citywide Statement of Needs for City Facilities to the City Council, Borough Presidents, borough boards and community boards. The Statement, prepared as part of the City’s “fair share” siting process, identifies all new facilities the City plans to site and all existing facilities the City plans to close or to significantly expand or reduce in size during the ensuing two fiscal years. The Borough Presidents and community boards have the opportunity to comment on the proposed projects within 90 days of the statement’s release.

Sections 12(c) and 204(h) of the Charter require that the Mayor’s Management Report review the implementation of proposals in the Statement. The following chart provides the status, as of June 30, 2014 of all actions proposed by City agencies in the Citywide Statement of Needs for Fiscal Years 2014 and 2015. Where appropriate, the locations of sited and implemented projects are indicated.

STATUS DEFINITIONS

Completed	Proposal for which a ULURP or Section 195 application received final approval; or for which a contract for operation of a facility was approved; or for which a facility was located in existing City space; or for which an expansion, reduction or closing was completed.
In Progress	ULURP or Section 195 application filed but not yet approved; or contractor selected but contract has not yet received final approval; or expansion/reduction of existing site is underway.
Active	City still actively seeking site for facility, or ULURP or Section 195 Application has not yet been filed or no contractor has been selected.
Modified	Proposal was modified and is included in this Statement or will be included in a later Statement.
Cancelled	City is no longer actively seeking site or implementing proposal because of fiscal or programmatic considerations.
