The EECBG program assists state, local, and tribal governments in implementing strategies to: reduce fossil fuel emissions, reduce total energy use, and improve energy efficiency in the transportation, building and other appropriate sectors.

**Grant Description:**

DCAS DEM EECBG proposal included projects and programs to advance the goals of *PlaNYC* and the *Long-Term Plan to Reduce Energy Consumption and Greenhouse Gas Emissions of Municipal Buildings and Operations*, including an energy audit program, comprehensive energy efficient building retrofits, improved operations & maintenance (O&M), investment grade studies for clean distributed generation installations, a revolving loan fund to support private sector retrofits, and a program to improve energy code compliance.

**Grant Amount:** \$80,802,900

**Anticipated benefits:**

The implementation of the retrofits and the O&M measures will reduce the City government's energy consumption and greenhouse gas emissions, while also improving local air quality. The energy audits and clean, distributed generation analysis will provide the City with information to best leverage additional City and State funds to further reduce energy consumption and emissions. In addition, the EECBG implementation will provide funding for private sector retrofits, improve compliance of energy standards and spur the local green economy for the workers and products necessary to implement it.
