ARRA Funding Source: Early Head Start

Funding Source Description: Funding will support the expansion of the child care collaborative model in New York City and provide enhanced services to children ages 0 to 2, and their families. This will increase the number of families served in this high need category, as well as create new teaching and other positions in existing early care and education programs.

Grant Description: Expansion money will be used to develop Early Head start services in communities that are underserved by the existing Early Care and Education system and have existing capacity to develop new home visiting and center based service models.

Grant Amount: \$4.2M in FY 10 and \$3.7M in FY 11

Anticipated benefits: Expansion money will enable NYC to serve 132 pregnant women, infants and toddlers from low-income families with Early Head Start services in communities that are currently underserved by publicly funded Early Care and Education services. We expect to expand capacity in three high need communities using these funds.
