ARRA Funding Source: Grant Applications for the Health Care Sector and Other High Growth and Emerging Industries

Funding Source Description: The Health Care Sector and Other High Growth and Emerging Industries competitive grant provides approximately \$220 million to public entities and private non-profit organizations that provide training and placement services to help workers pursue careers in health care and other fields.

Grant Description: City College of New York (CCNY) proposes to expand current workforce development projects and launch new projects at the Upper Manhattan Healthcare Workforce Initiative. The projects included in this initiative will provide education, training and placement services to help unemployed, dislocated and incumbent workers, including low-wage and limited English proficient workers, pursue careers within the health care industry.

Grant Amount: \$3 million

Anticipated benefits: This program would provide for 600 enrollments in the Health Care Career Management Center at CCNY, 275 job placements and 100 young adults trained in Healthcare Career Exploration. It would also provide training for a minimum of 125 participants in the Healthcare Career Pathways, which trains individuals in occupations difficult to fill in local hospitals, including pharmacy, laboratory, administration and long-term care. Finally, funding would support the development of courses and modules to support health care functions.
