Funding Source Description:

The purpose of this funding is to enable federal Section 317 grantees (CDC Immunization funding) to develop the capacity for billing health insurance plans for services provided to health plan members by state and local health department clinics.

Grant Description: Funding will be awarded to develop strategic plan for clinical & fiscal operations, including selection of new IT system for billing. Funding requested to support a consultant to assist in enrolling agency as eligible provider in top NYC private insurance plans and improvements to electronic health record for Bureau of Immunization to permit data collection for billing services to all patients.

Grant Amount: \$411,160

Anticipated benefits:

With improved electronic data collection system & business model for collecting/transmitting data, DOHMH will be able to increase insurance revenue for Immunization services. This benefit will quickly inure to all DOHMH clinical programs as the model is scaled up for increased billing capacity and revenues for all clinical services.
