### **Funding Source Description:**

ARRA TSGP specifically will focus on the use of visible, unpredictable deterrence through the funding of Operational Packages for canine teams, mobile explosives detection screening teams, and Anti-Terrorism Teams both due to their effectiveness in reducing risk to transit systems and their potential for job creation. In addition, funding will be provided for capital projects including Multi-User High-Density Key Infrastructure Protection, Single-User High-Density Key Infrastructure Protection, Key Operating Asset Protection, and Other Mitigation Activities.

### **Grant Description:**

The NYPD applied under the FFY 09 ARRA Transit Security Grant Program – Capital (TSGP) for a Capital Asset Hardening Project as a sub-grantee of the Metropolitan Transportation Authority (MTA). This project seeks to procure and install 350 License Plate Reader (LPR) cameras at or in the vicinity of transit facilities as an expansion of the Lower Manhattan Security Initiative into Midtown Manhattan.

**Grant Amount:** \$18,200,000.00

### **Anticipated benefits:**

This project would expand the LPR coverage of the Lower Manhattan Security Initiative (LMSI) and be fully integrated with the LMSI Domain Awareness.
