RCMS Receives Green IT Award

The Department's Office Information Technology was honored at the 2009 Excellence in Technology Award Program for the creation of The Reusable Case Management System (RCMS), an information-sharing system that has saved nearly 5 million sheets of paper along with a large amount of toner and ink since it was deployed in 2008.

Probation was awarded the Green IT Award on behalf of Mayor Michael Bloomberg and Commissioner Paul Cosgrave of the Department of Information Technology and Telecommunications.

RCMS is a notification-based workflow system that automates information-sharing between different DOP units and critical external stakeholders in the courts and other criminal justice agencies at the Federal, State, and City levels. In addition to providing faster and more accurate service than the previous paper-based process, RCMS has dramatically reduced the amount of paper and supplies consumed monthly. Designed to be scalable for small and large jurisdictions alike, RCMS has helped DOP work smarter, strategically, efficiently and "greener."

The award was presented to Acting Commissioner Patricia Brennan, Deputy Commissioner for IT Alphonzo Albright, Executive Director of OIT Andrej Jachimczyk, Director of Applications Anibal Sempertegui and project manager Mazibur Ansari.
