NYPD COMMUNITY PARTNERSHIP PROGRAM

The Police Dept. has initiated a new program to improve and increase the number of positive contacts Patrol Officers have with the community. Patrol Officers will be introducing themselves to businesses, religious institutions, civic associations and schools in the neighborhood.

LAWN LITTER LAW

The Lawn Litter Law allows residents to place a sign on their property to stop unwanted literature and advertisements from being left on their property. The sign must state in at least one inch letters "Do Not Place Unsolicited Advertising Materials On This Property." The sign must also be at least five inches tall and seven inches wide and placed in a conspicuous location on the homeowner's property. This law imposes a civil penalty, between \$250 and \$1,000 on businesses that do not adhere to the posted sign. The Department of Sanitation will be the enforcing agency for the implementation of the rules and regulations of the Lawn Litter Law. **Signs are available at the CB11 District Office.**
