## CONSTRUCTION UPDATES

**PS 130** – Construction in progress on the replacement of school windows – Completion due August 2009.

**PS 188** - Exterior renovation work in progress including masonry and windows – Completion due January 2010.

**MS 74** – Work in progress on roof for asbestos abatement – Completion due August 2009.

For safety reasons, all work at PS 130, PS 188 and MS 74 must take place after normal school hours from 3:30 PM to 11 PM. Noisy work will cease at 10 PM. Work may also take place during daytime hours on weekends and holidays.

**SEQ200465** – 210 St. between 35 Ave. & 34 Rd. – Installation of storm sewers. Work began mid November and is scheduled to take place for the next six weeks. Following that time, there will be a six-week break in work before they return to the site.

## AUTOMATIC METER READING PROGRAM

DEP is moving forward with Automatic Meter Reading (AMR) technology to improve water metering. The AMR will consist of small, low-powered radio transmitters connected to individual water meters that send daily readings to a network of rooftop receivers throughout the City. The AMR will provide DEP with the ability to eventually transfer to monthly billing and eliminate the need for a meter reader to visit customer properties. Contractor installation in Queens will start in January 2009.
