NYS DOT INTELLIGENT TRANSPORTATION SYSTEM

NYS Department of Transportation is currently installing real time cameras, message signs and fiber optic networks for advisory radio transmissions to provide the public with various forms of travel information on all our highways. You will see more message signs to advise you about traffic congestion and estimated travel times. NYS/ NYC Departments of Transportation, in conjunction with NYPD and OEM, operates a 24/7 operation center monitoring incoming traffic data to better manage traffic in the City. Travel information is available now at www.nyctmc.org and Channel 92 on the Time Warner Cable station, and as a Verizon FIOS TV Widget. You can also call 511 for traffic information in the City.

TAXI & LIMOUSINE COMMISSION PASSENGER GUIDE

NOTIFY NYC

Notify NYC is the City's official source for information about emergency events and important City services. Registration is free via nyc.gov/notifynyc or by calling 311. You can sign up to receive neighborhood-specific emergency alerts and updates by e-mail, text messages or recorded phone calls. Notify NYC can provide updates for up to five zip codes of your choosing.

FAIR HOUSING PROGRAM

The NY Urban League's Fair Housing Program offers services to prevent discrimination in housing and in creating housing opportunities for low and moderate income individuals. WEATHERIZATION ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

The Weatherization Assistance Program provides free or low-cost energy efficiency services to low-income households, particularly the elderly, families with children and the disabled. Trained weatherization crews perform on-site home energy audits to identify outside drafts and inspect heating system efficiency. Once installed, the energy saving measures can help reduce heating and cooling costs. You must meet specific income guidelines established by the Federal government to be eligible. ALZHEIMER'S SAFE RETURN PROGRAM

The Safe Return Program assists in the safe return of individuals with Alzheimer's and related dementias who become lost. Persons enrolled in the program receive ID bracelets, wallet cards and other identifiers. For more information, call toll free (800) 272-3900.

NYC FluLine

Through the NYC FluLine, New Yorkers can call 311 and operators will provide information on what to do if you or a family member feels sick with flu-like illness, fever with a cough or sore throat. Callers with symptoms of the flu will be connected to a registered nurse who will provide information and advise them on whether to seek medical care.
