## CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

- In-house milling and resurfacing of streets and installation of pedestrian ramps is ongoing throughout the district.
- HWS2008QC – Prior Notice Sidewalk Repair Contract starting in summer 2008.
- NYS Dept. of Transportation Projects – Federal funds have been allocated for the replacement of the Bell Blvd. Bridge over the LIE and the rehabilitation of eight bridges at the Clearview Expwy. and Grand Central Pkwy. interchange.
- Alley Creek and Little Neck Bay Waterbody/Watershed Facility Plan – At the CB11 Office, you can view the report outlining the work that has been done to date to improve water quality in Little Neck Bay and the progress of the construction of the Combined Sewer Overflows in Alley Creek. The public is invited to send questions and comments by June 20<sup>th</sup> to NYS Dept. of Environmental Conservation.
- NYC Dept. of Parks Tree and Sidewalk Program to start this year. Repair is based on a priority system.
- Throgs Neck Bridge – Lane closures southbound to Queens. One lane will be closed from May 30<sup>th</sup> to June 14<sup>th</sup>.
