The Dept. of Transportation will be replacing all remaining single-space parking meters with muni-meters throughout Queens between July 18, 2011 and February, 2012. The rates will be \$1.00 an hour or \$.25 for 15 minutes.

STOP THE NOISE!

Many residents ask us about the permitted hours for construction and gardeners. The NYC Noise Code states the following: Power tools, such as lawn mowers and leaf blowers, may only be used between 8 am and 7 pm (or until sunset, whichever occurs later), on weekdays and between 9 am and 6 pm on holidays and weekends.

Construction is permitted between 7 am and 6 pm on weekdays. However, alterations and repairs to existing one- or two-family owner-occupied dwellings may occur on Saturdays and Sundays between 10 am and 4 pm, provided the dwelling is located more than 300 feet from a house of worship. The Dept. of Buildings can authorize permits for work after hours and on weekends under special circumstances.
