CB11 NEEDS TO SAVE MONEY AND GO PAPERLESS

Beginning this month, all City agencies, including CB11, have to cut their budgets. Therefore, we are urging you to “go paperless” and give us your e-mail address for future newsletters and agendas. Depending on the financial situation, the Community Boards are facing additional severe cuts next July. At that time, we may not be able to provide a newsletter via snail mail.

CB11 SNOW SHOVELERS

LEAF COLLECTION

Sanitation will not have special leaf collection pick-ups this year. Leaves should be put out for collection with the regular garbage. You are not required to use brown bags. Instead, you can compost your leaves. You can place them in a large container and mulch the leaves with a weed whacker. These mulched leaves can then be used for compost.

NIGHT COLLECTION

Sanitation will begin winter night collection on November 10th. Residents should remember to put their garbage out starting at 5 PM the night before a scheduled pick-up day. The area for night collection in our district is Sect. 2. The general boundaries are Northern Blvd., north to 26 Ave., from the Clearview Expwy. to the Cross Island Pkwy.
