## **LEAF COLLECTION DAYS**

On Sunday, November 18<sup>th</sup> and Sunday, December 2<sup>nd</sup> homeowners can put out leaves in **paper bags or unlined containers only**. Place the bags or containers curbside on the Saturday evening before pick-up.

## **SPECIAL WASTE DROP-OFF SITE**

Residents can bring hazardous waste to the Sanitation Queens 7 Garage located on 30<sup>th</sup> Ave. between 121 St. and 122 St., between 7 AM and 3 PM, on the first three Saturdays of the month and the last Friday of the month. Items that will be collected include oil, tires, batteries, fluorescent lights, dry paint cans. ## **SNOW**

Sanitation has announced that “night plow” hours start on November 12<sup>th</sup>. Select areas in the District will have garbage collected between the hours of midnight and 8 AM. The Department is also looking to register emergency snow laborers who are hired to clear bus stops, fire hydrants and corners. It pays \$12 to \$18 an hour, and you can register at any Sanitation garage on Monday to Friday, 7 AM to 3 PM.

## DO NOT CALL REGISTRY

The Federal Trade Commission (FTC) started the registry in June 2003 to help consumers control telemarketing calls. The FTC which oversees the list established a 5 year expiration. If your number is set to expire next year, you may want to re-register now to prevent any lapse in coverage.
