



SEWER REPAIR ADVISORY

Beginning Friday, January 8, 2016 and continuing for approximately 5-7 days*, the NYC Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) will be performing emergency sewer repair work in Queens **Community Board #13**. We thank you for your patience and understanding as we work to upgrade and maintain New York City's infrastructure. Following are the specific details of the repair work and a brief overview of anticipated community impacts.

COMMUNITY IMPACTS

WHAT ARE THE HOURS OF CONSTRUCTION?

Construction will typically occur Monday through Friday, between the hours of 7:00am and 3:30pm. However, the contractor may go beyond those hours (but no later than 6PM) in order to complete certain work operations within the same day.

WILL MY WATER BE TURNED OFF?

Certain operations may require a temporary water service interruption. If an interruption is necessary, you will receive written notification the day before the scheduled interruption.

WHAT CAN I EXPECT TO SEE DURING CONSTRUCTION?

DEP is committed to maintaining a clean and safe work site. However, dust, noise and heavy equipment/machinery are common elements of construction. The following are some of the temporary impacts that may be required during construction:

CURBSIDE PARKING

Parking may be temporarily eliminated in order to facilitate work operations. DEP will provide advance notification before any parking is eliminated.

DETOURS/STREET CLOSURES

These may be necessary during certain operations. Advance notice of any detours or lane closures will be posted in advance.

PEDESTRIAN ACCESS TO HOMES AND BUILDINGS

Access will be maintained at all times. However, temporary sidewalk walkways may be required during certain operations.

DRIVEWAY/LOADING DOCK ACCESS

Access may be temporarily restricted during the workday. Full access will be restored at the end of the day. DEP will coordinate any restrictions with the property owner in advance.
