WHY IS MY WATER BEING TURNED OFF?

A water service interruption is necessary to facilitate the replacement of fire hydrants. The shutdown is anticipated to begin at 11:30pm and last for approximately five (5) hours. This work may be completed earlier and water service restored.

SOME THINGS TO REMEMBER:

- The DDC recommends that you shut off the water main valve in your house/building in order to avoid problems that may occur if/when sediment enters or is released from your plumbing.
- You are asked to shut off all WATER cooled appliances, which may include air conditioners, etc.
- Once water service is returned, turn the main house valve back on and flush the system by running your faucets, sinks and tubs, for a few minutes.
