

### Starting this October, NYC DOT will implement bicycle routes on Greenpoint Avenue & Honeywell Street Bridge:

- Install a new bicycle route on Greenpoint Avenue, connecting the recently installed bicycle path on Greenpoint Avenue Bridge to the new bicycle path on Queens Boulevard
- Install a new bicycle path on the Honeywell Street Bridge
- Redesign roadway to improve traffic flow and calm traffic
- Install a new dedicated left-turn signal and lane markings on Greenpoint Avenue at the Long Island Expressway

## Implementation starts Mid-October
