QUEENS BLVD. - ROOSEVELT AVE. TO 73rd ST. Corridor Safety Improvements

Install Protected Bike Lanes

Shorten Crossing Distances

NYC DOT will implement safety improvements along Queens Blvd. from Roosevelt Ave. to 73rd St.:

- Install protected pedestrian path and bicycle lane along service road medians
- Reconfigure how vehicles access the Brooklyn Queens Expressway from Queens Blvd.
- Redesign the slip lanes connecting the service and main roads
- Install new signal and slip lane from main road to service road at 64th St.
- Install new mall-to-mall crosswalks to connect service road medians
- Install new midblock signal and crosswalk near 73rd St.
