### NYC Department of Sanitation

#### **Residents**

New York City Will be contributing zero waste to landfills by 2030.

There's no "away" when we throw garbage into a can or litter basket. Trash goes into landfills, where it decomposes – sending methane, carbon dioxide and toxins into our air, soil and water. By contributing zero waste to landfills by 2030, New Yorkers will be protecting their environment more than ever before.

The best way to keep garbage from landfills is by limiting the materials you use. Reduce use when you can – and reuse and recycle the rest. For example, opt out from receiving [junk mail](#), and [donate or sell items](#) you no longer need.

#### **Businesses**

Businesses play a crucial role in protecting our environment. Instead of generating waste destined for landfills, standard operations should include reducing the use of materials, reusing when possible and recycling.

#### **Schools**

All schools in New York City, public and private, are crucial to helping our City contribute zero waste to landfills by 2030 – and all schools must meet DSNY guidelines for separating recyclables and setting out recycling and garbage for collection.

Properly installed and maintained smoke alarms save lives and protect against injury and loss due to fire. The fire death rate in homes with working smoke alarms is 51% less than the rate for homes without this protection. Having a working smoke alarm reduces one's chances of dying in a fire by nearly half.



### DOB Issues Updated Crane Regulations

The NYC DOB updated the crane regulations after the crawler crane collapse in February. The updated regulations: Bar from City streets any crawler crane to shut down in winds of less than 20 miles per hour; require a licensed engineer be present for less than 30mph winds; prohibit all crane operations whenever winds exceed 30mph. DOB is raising the base penalty for failure to safeguard cranes from \$4,800 to \$10,000. There will also be more sidewalk protection for pedestrians. There will be improved notification for surrounding residents and businesses. Prior to moving a crane, operators are required to notify those who live or work in the area. Previously, crane operators were required to notify residents and businesses only when the crane is first installed.

#### Travel Warning for Pregnant Women - Zika Virus

Pregnant and traveling? Learn about Zika virus, and consider delaying travel to affected areas until health experts say it's safe. Zika spreads to people through mosquito bites-but not a bite from any mosquito. The mosquito that health experts believe spreads the virus lives in certain parts of the world. Zika is affecting parts of Central and South America, Mexico and the Caribbean. Most people infected with Zika don't get sick. However, Zika may cause birth defects. There is no vaccine. ## Con Edison *Energy Efficiency*

All New Yorkers got the benefit of declining energy prices in 2015, but 28,300 Con Edison customers found an additional way to save money: they got rebates from the utility for making energy-saving upgrades. Those customers received \$44 million in incentives from Con Edison for upgrades that included lighting, HVAC equipment, building management systems and other improvements. Con Edison's energy efficiency program provide multiple benefits to New Yorkers. The upgrades customers made last year prevent the emission of 111,800 tons of carbon into the air annually. In terms of greenhouse gas emissions, that's the equivalent of taking more than 23, 500 cars off the road.
