**Ed Koch Queensboro Bridge - Planned Electric Work
Wednesday, September 21, 2016**

Con Edison will resume work on the Ed Koch Queensboro Bridge to upgrade the electric system. We will be working seven nights a week through the end of the year at the following bridge locations:

- North Outer Roadway
 - 9pm to 5am
 - Starting Thursday September 22.
- Lower Inner Roadway, outside Manhattan-bound lane
 - 12:01am to 5:00am
 - Starting Thursday September 22.
- Lower inner Roadway, outside Queens-bound lane
 - 12:01am to 5:00am
 - Starting Monday October 3.

Community Impacts:

- Closure of bike lane/pedestrian walkway
- Free shuttle bus service between Queens Plaza North/Crescent to East 59th St/1st Avenue
- Bicycle transport vehicle for cyclists


No electric service interruptions are anticipated. We apologize for any inconvenience this work may cause. We will provide updates as more details become available.
