



New Kosciuszko Bridge

Construction Advisory: October 2016

The New York State Department of Transportation (NYSDOT) has awarded a \$555 million contract to construct Phase I of the new Kosciuszko Bridge. Upon completion, the new bridge will improve traffic safety, reduce congestion and improve travel speeds.

Please find below some of the work activities scheduled for the month of October 2016 that could impact you:

Brooklyn Connector, Brooklyn Approach and Local Street Reconstruction

- Long-term left lane closure on westbound Meeker Avenue, between Apollo and Sutton Streets, for installation of concrete barriers and removal of the remaining BQE structure. The right lane will remain open. NO PARKING or STANDING will be allowed on westbound Meeker Avenue between the above limits until further notice.
- Full closure of Morgan Avenue under the BQE viaduct, between eastbound and westbound Meeker Avenues, for removal and reconstruction of the remaining BQE structure.
- Temporary closure of Anthony Street, between Morgan and Vandervoort Avenues, for installation of utilities and roadway reconstruction. Access and egress for local traffic on Anthony Street will be available from Vandervoort Avenue only. No turns will be permitted between Morgan Avenue and Anthony Street.

Queens Connector, Queens Approach and Local Street Reconstruction

- Temporary partial closure of 56th Road, between Laurel Hill Boulevard and 43rd Street, for installation of Intelligent Transportation Systems (ITS).

Some of the previously-initiated work continuing in October includes:

Brooklyn Connector, Brooklyn Approach and Local Street Reconstruction

- Temporary shifting of eastbound Meeker Avenue traffic to the left side of the street, between Morgan and Vandervoort Avenues, to establish work zone needed for roadway reconstruction and paving.
- Shifting of westbound BQE traffic onto newly constructed pavement of the Brooklyn Connector, between Vandervoort and Morgan Avenues.

- Installation of new water main on Morgan Avenue, between eastbound and westbound Meeker Avenues.
- Placement of concrete slabs for roadway deck for new Brooklyn connector, between Vandervoort and Stewart Avenues.
- Closure of Varick Avenue, between Thomas and Anthony Streets, for partial removal of existing BQE structure and roadway reconstruction (through November 2016).
- Construction of new abutments at Morgan Avenue under the BQE viaduct.
- Removal and reconstruction of the BQE structure, between the westbound BQE off-ramp (Exit 34-Meeker/Morgan Avenues) and Apollo Street. Two (2) 11-foot-wide lanes will remain open at all times.
- Implementation of one-way traffic patterns on Vandervoort and Morgan Avenues under the BQE viaduct. Continuing through the end of 2016, only northbound Morgan Avenue traffic and only southbound Vandervoort Avenue traffic will be permitted beneath the viaduct.
- Temporary closure of sidewalk on eastbound Meeker Avenue, between Vandervoort and Kingsland Avenues, for roadway and sidewalk reconstruction and temporary removal of B24 bus stop at Morgan and eastbound Meeker Avenues (through October 2016).
- Temporary closure of sidewalk on Vandervoort Avenue, between eastbound Meeker Avenue and Anthony Street (through October 2016).
- Realignment of eastbound Meeker Avenue, including installation of new sidewalks and curbs, between Morgan and Vandervoort Avenues.

Queens Connector, Queens Approach and Local Street Reconstruction

- Placement of concrete slabs for roadway deck for new Queens connector, between 55th Avenue and 54th Road.
- Continuation of construction and shifting of traffic onto new BQE on-ramps: from westbound LIE to westbound BQE and from Laurel Hill Boulevard to westbound BQE.
- Closure of 54th Avenue, between Laurel Hill Boulevard and 43rd Street (until further notice), for underground utility work on 54th Avenue and construction of new abutments.
- Temporary closure of 56th Road, between Laurel Hill Boulevard and 43rd Street, for installation of utilities.

Advance notices for specific activities will be distributed to residents and businesses prior to the start of work (water interruptions, traffic lane closures, detours, etc.)

The construction schedule is subject to change due to weather and unforeseen field conditions.

The project team will make every effort to minimize impacts during this large construction project.
