RESTRICTIONS TO CURBSIDE PARKING AND DRIVEWAY ACCESS

(NIGHT-TIME WORK OPERATIONS)**

On/about the week of August 22, 2016, the NYC Department of Design and Construction (DDC) will begin the Milling Project #HW2CR16D. The anticipated completion date for the locations listed below is August 26, 2016.

WHERE WILL WORK BE PERFORMED?

Work will be performed at the following locations:

- Grand Central Parkway Service Road from Utopia Parkway to 168 St
- Review Ave from Laurel Hill Blvd to Greenpoint Ave
- Laurel Hill Blvd from Review Ave to 56 Rd
- 56 Rd from Laurel Hill Blvd to 43 St
- 37 St from Review Ave to Bradley Ave
- Bradley Ave from 37 St to Van Dam St
- 35 St from Borden Ave to Bradley Ave
- Gale Ave from Greenpoint Ave to 35 St
- Starr Ave from 37 St to Borden Ave
- 34 St from Van Dam St to Borden Ave
- Borough Place from 50 St to 27 Ave
- 27 Ave from Brooklyn/Queens Expressway Service Road [Southbound] to 30 Ave
- Brooklyn/Queens Expressway Service Road [Southbound] from 49 St to 27 Ave
- Brooklyn/Queens Expressway Service Road [Northbound] from 30 Ave to 49 St
- Metropolitan Ave from Union Turnpike to Woodhaven Blvd
- 58 St from Laurel Hill Blvd to Queens Blvd
- Hillside Ave from Little Neck Parkway to Langdale St.

WHAT WORK WILL BE DONE?

Work scheduled on this project includes the milling of streets in preparation for resurfacing by the NYC Department of Transportation Roadway Repair & Maintenance (RRM) division.

WHAT ARE THE COMMUNITY IMPACTS?

The DDC is committed to maintaining a work site that is safe and clean. However, dust, noise and heavy equipment are common elements of construction and we ask for your patience during the project. There may be limited street access on certain blocks. However, deliveries to residential properties and emergency vehicle access will be allowed.

Pedestrian / Traffic

- ❖ Pedestrian access to buildings will be maintained at all times.
- ❖ Street closures may be required; warning signs will be posted in advance.
- ❖ Driveway access may be temporarily interrupted in order to complete construction.

Public Transportation

- ❖ If/when necessary, bus stops and/or bus routes may be relocated/detoured during the course of this construction. Signs and directions will be posted noting the changes.

No Parking Notification

- ❖ Dedicated "No Parking" signs will be posted in all affected areas for the specific day/days for this work operation.

WHAT ARE THE HOURS OF WORK?

Typical work hours will be Monday-Friday from 6:00pm to 6:00am.
