On/about the week of March 22, 2016, the City of New York Department of Design and Construction (DDC) is scheduled to perform Green Infrastructure/Right of Way Bioswale installation at various locations. The contractor will begin saw-cutting in preparation for the installation of Right of Way Bioswale installation. To facilitate these activities, parking restrictions will be in effect. **"No Parking"** signs will be posted for the duration of these activities.

**WHERE WILL WORK BE PERFORMED?**

Work will be performed on various locations as listed below.

- 55<sup>th</sup> Rd between Maurice Ave and Borden Ave.
- Borden Ave between 55<sup>th</sup> Rd and 60<sup>th</sup> St.
- 55<sup>th</sup> Dr between 58<sup>th</sup> St and Grand Ave.
- Hull Ave between 64<sup>th</sup> St and Remsen Pl.
- 56<sup>th</sup> Ave between 59<sup>th</sup> St and 64<sup>th</sup> St.
- Clinton Ave between 64<sup>th</sup> St and Remsen Pl.
- 56<sup>th</sup> Rd between 59<sup>th</sup> St and 64<sup>th</sup> St.
- 56<sup>th</sup> Dr between Maurice Ave and 61<sup>st</sup> St.
- Perry Ave between Remsen Pl and Hamilton Pl.
- Maspeth Ave between 59<sup>th</sup> St and 64<sup>th</sup> St.
- 57<sup>th</sup> Rd between 58<sup>th</sup> Pl and 59<sup>th</sup> St.
- 57<sup>th</sup> Dr between 59<sup>th</sup> St and 61<sup>st</sup> St.
- 58<sup>th</sup> Ave between 58<sup>th</sup> Pl St and Grand Ave.
- Grand Ave between 58<sup>th</sup> Pl St and 58<sup>th</sup> Ave.
- Maurice Ave between 56<sup>th</sup> Ave and Maspeth Ave.

- 58<sup>th</sup> Pl between 58<sup>th</sup> Rd and Grand Ave.
- 59<sup>th</sup> St between 56<sup>th</sup> Ave and Grand Ave.
- 59<sup>th</sup> Place between 56<sup>th</sup> Dr and Maspeth Ave.
- 64<sup>th</sup> St between 56<sup>th</sup> Rd and 56<sup>th</sup> Dr.
- 65<sup>th</sup> St between Grand Ave and Dead end.
- Remsen Pl between Hull Ave and Clinton Ave.

#### WHAT WORK WILL BE DONE?

Scheduled work for this project is saw cutting, excavation, backfilling with layers of stone and engineered soil and tree-planting along with installation of tree guards.

#### WHAT ARE THE COMMUNITY IMPACTS?

Limited "No Parking" restrictions will be in effect during the construction. The contractor will post NO PARKING signs in advance of construction throughout the affected area. The contractor will tow vehicles found in violation of the "No Parking" restrictions. Contact the CCL for the towing list.

#### Pedestrian / Traffic

- ❖ Pedestrian access to buildings will be maintained at all times.
- ❖ Street closures may be required; warning signs will be posted in advance.
- ❖ Driveway access may be temporarily interrupted in order to complete construction.

#### Public transportation


- ❖ Bus stops and/or bus routes may be relocated/detoured during the course of this construction. Signs and directions will be posted noting the changes.
